### **CCS Midstream Services Builds Transfer Station to Complement TRD Facility**

Fox Creek, April 18, 2009 – CCS Midstream Services opened the doors of its new transfer station along Highway 43 on April 18. The facility will accept produced water, emulsion and terminalling oil around the clock.

“This transfer station allows us to better accommodate our customers with the close proximity to the highway,” said Jim Zenert, CCS Facility Manager. “We were also pleased to work with many local suppliers on the construction of the transfer station and even more pleased to welcome several local residents as CCS employees.”

CCS has been a proud member of the Fox Creek community since 1997 when it opened the doors to its existing Treatment, Recovery and Disposal (TRD) facility located eight kilometres off Highway 43 on Bigstone Road. With two facilities operating 24 hours a day, CCS can handle all waste streams from our oil and gas customers.

“I have lived in Fox Creek since 1996 and started at CCS as an operator when the doors first opened,” said Zenert. “CCS sets the industry standard for waste management. Everyday, I’m amazed at how immaculate our facilities look and how effectively they operate. Our people take pride in what they do and it shows. CCS returns that pride by supporting its employees and providing opportunities for growth – I’m proof of that. I started as an operator and today, I run the facility.”

The CCS-developed Gravity Compression System (GCS) maximizes the effects of heat, time and pressure to separate the waste, leading to improved recovery of valuable hydrocarbons and fewer residual wastes.

As a proud member of the community, CCS has supported many initiatives from fundraising efforts to curling bonspiels to little leagues. Where possible, CCS donates money to many worthy causes in the area. Employees are equally committed and are often seen volunteering their time to give back.
