CCS Midstream Services Open House at the New High Prairie TRD Facility

High Prairie, September 9, 2009 – CCS Midstream Services is hosting an open house at our new Treatment Recovery and Disposal facility (TRD) located 13.5 km South of High Prairie on Hwy 749 on September 18. The facility accepts produced water, upstream oil and gas waste, emulsion and terminalling oil, 7:00am – 12:00am, 7 days a week.

“This new facility allows us to better accommodate our customers needs. With our new riser system we can have up to six trucks unloading at the same time, which significantly reduces waiting time for our customers,” said Steven Petite, CCS Facility Manager. “We were also pleased to work with many local suppliers on the construction of the TRD and even more pleased to have several local residents as CCS employees.”

CCS has been a proud member of the High Prairie community since 1989, when CCS purchased the facility from Golden Rainbow. The plant was expanded in 1997 and then relocated across the road in 2008. This new location provides more space for the state-of-the-art facility which features a solids pad, blending skid and processing area. With the facility operating daily from 7:00am – 12:00am, CCS can handle all upstream waste streams from our oil and gas customers.
