Buck Creek, September 21, 2009 – CCS Midstream Services is pleased to announce the opening of our newest Treatment Recovery and Disposal facility (TRD) located 35 km's Southeast of Drayton Valley, Alberta on Highway 22. With the facility open daily from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m., CCS can handle all upstream waste from our oil and gas customers.

"This new facility will provide better access to our customers in Drayton Valley and the surrounding area," said Brian Huseby, CCS Facility Manager. "Our TRD model offers a number of unique services including an area to steam and flush trucks, equipment cleaning, and a riser system that allows multiple trucks to unload at the same time."

Our TRDs are designed with safety in mind with state-of-the-art safety controls including light and sound indicators that immediately alert employees and visitors if there are any issues detected anywhere on the property. All visitors are required to complete a safety orientation before conducting business. Our TRDs also feature a solids pad, onsite treater, Optimization skid and processing area. The facility accepts upstream wastes including: produced water, upstream oil and gas waste, and, emulsion and terminalling oil.

"CCS truly sets the industry standard for safe, environmentally responsible handling of oilfield waste," says Huseby. "Everyday, I'm amazed at how immaculate our facilities look and how effectively they operate. Opening a new facility provides opportunities for local residents as well. We are pleased to have several local residents as CCS employees. We were also pleased to work with many local suppliers on the construction of the TRD."
