Hesje has a degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Saskatchewan and brings over 30 years' experience working in the energy industry not only in Canada but around the world. His experience spans pipeline construction, the natural gas industry, consulting and international business development. He has worked in senior roles with Nova, Amoco, Willbros MSI Canada Inc. and the Transportadora de Gas del Norte in Argentina as Chief Operating Officer.

“Ralph has the experience, knowledge and drive required to continue the growth of our CCS model not only in Canada, but in the United States and internationally,” said David Werklund, President and Chief Executive Officer. “Our culture at CCS attracts the best talent and Ralph is no exception. He is a true leader and I’m excited about the opportunity to work with him.”

Hesje will lead CCS’ strategic growth in the American market, including our current operations in Louisiana, Alabama and Texas. CCS Income Trust owns an industrial waste water treatment plant in the Port of Shreveport, Louisiana. CCS also owns and operates three transfer stations and two processing facilities in the states of Louisiana and Alabama. CCS Energy Services LLC provides waste treatment and disposal services to the off-shore Gulf Coast oil and gas market. This also includes two salt caverns located in Weeks Island, Louisiana. Conditional upon due diligence as well as regulatory and other approvals, CCS would develop the site and caverns for disposal and treatment of oil and gas exploration and production waste.

“I am impressed with CCS’ strategic approach to growth and its commitment to environmental stewardship around the globe,” said Hesje. “CCS’ service model and innovative technology are the foundation for its potential to continue to grow now and in the future. It has a proven track record of success here in Canada with over 20 years of operations under its belt.”

CCS operates two disposal caverns in Alberta and Saskatchewan and one storage cavern in Alberta.

Ralph C. Hesje, P.Eng., was the President of Willbros MSI Canada Inc. since April 2003. He has a degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Saskatchewan graduating in 1973. He has worked in the energy industry since 1974, beginning his career with Nova (Alberta Gas Trunk Line). During his 22 years at Nova he was part of a team building pipeline and compressor facilities and a number of new businesses. He has worked in Latin America in the Natural Gas industry from 1992 to 1996 as the Chief Operating Officer of Transportadora de Gas del Norte in Argentina. During this period he was also responsible for Business Development for Nova in the region. It was during this time that the Gasandes pipeline project was developed.

Mr. Hesje spent 2 years with Amoco as Vice President Business Development in Latin America and owned a consulting practice in Houston providing management consulting services for the energy industry.

Mr. Hesje is currently a member of the Board of Directors at SaskEnergy and Heritage Gas. He serves as Chair of the Human Resources and Compensation Committee of the SaskEnergy Board and is on the Audit and Finance Committee of Heritage Gas. He has also served on a number of other boards including five international companies in Brazil and Argentina and non-profit boards in Argentina and Houston, Texas.

Mr. Hesje brings many years of industry engineering, construction and business experience to this role.
