### **Lionhead Completes Downhole Abandonment Operations at Dingman #2 Well**

Turner Valley, September 9, 2009 – Lionhead Engineering has completed the downhole abandonment of the Dingman #2 well in accordance with current ERCB regulations. Lionhead's objectives have been to protect the Sheep River and useable groundwaters that the wellbore penetrates, and to stop the sour gas that is flowing directly from the well.

"We have achieved our objectives set out at the start of this abandonment operation by abandoning the well in accordance with ERCB regulations, protecting useable groundwaters and stopping the flow of sour gas from the well," said Kary Cuthill, President, Lionhead Engineering. "We are extremely proud of the work that was done on this abandonment and I would like to congratulate all of our industry and government partners on their contributions to making this abandonment successful."

"There were many challenges that we faced with abandoning this historic well. The drilling rig phase was successful because of the strong cross-functional technical team we assembled for this well abandonment and the exceptional collaboration between the key stakeholders in this project including our customer, Alberta Culture and Community Spirit, the ERCB, the Town of Turner Valley, and Lionhead," said Cuthill.

Lionhead will regularly monitor the wellbore and surrounding area for one year to ensure the gas flow has been eliminated for the long term, after which the surface abandonment will be completed.

Lionhead was contracted by Alberta Culture and Community Spirit to abandon Dingman #2 to current regulatory standards.
