Build Date	Plant was originally built in 1994 and upgrades to the site began in 2000 with a 50,000 m3 landfill built. In 2001 the receiving end of the plant was upgraded with a new GCS system, two bay hopper and a new mixing pad to the north, the south pad was also upgraded adding 4' walls around the north west and east sides of the pad. In 2002 the tank farm was upgraded with all new piping utilidoor and tank gages.
Plant Bio	Plant employs five operators, one administrator and one manager. Each summer we employ between 1 and 3 summer students from the community as well. CCS Gull Lake is very active in the community both through sponsorship programs and volunteering as well.
Sweet or sour service	Strictly sweet, all of our customers scavenge for h2s if necessary before hauling in their waste
